

The Last Will & Testament of Angelina Isbell

Nov 24th 1892. This is my last Will as to what shall be done with my property after my death

First

I want all just debts paid And then I want to give to Dora Isbell one feather bed and bed clothes And to Alla Julian one feather bed and bed clothes And to Lafayette Isbell I give one Coverlet. And to James Isbell I give one quilt And then I want all my property of every kind sold by Luke P Gillum and W J Isbell who shall be required to give Bond in reasonable amount for faithful discharge of this Will

And then after paying all necessary expenses I want my brother Houston Beasley to have Fifty dollars in money And my niece Bate Julian Twenty five dollars in money and I want said Luke P Gillum & W J Isbell to Collect all money due me and after paying the above parties I want what money is left of my estate to be divided equally between my niece Linda Allison ^{wife of W. Allison} and Margarette C Gillum. Wm J Isbell. Luke P Gillum & P. J Allison I am now in my proper and right mind and I make this as my last Will of my own mind without any one dictating to me as to what I should do with my property This Nov 24th 1892
