CONSTITUTION—ARTICLE III.
MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1. None but persons who have served honorably in the Army or Navy of the late Confederate States during the war between the States, serving until the close of the war, unless previously discharged for real physical disability, or honorably released from service, having an unimpeachable war record, and of good standing since, can be members of this organization.

SEC. 2. The President shall appoint a committee of five, said committee to be known as the Committee on Credentials, to whom shall be referred all applications for membership, and who shall hear the proof of the applicant, and report the same back to this Association for reception or rejection.

BY-LAWS.—ARTICLE I.
MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1. All applications for membership must be presented in writing at a regular meeting; must state full name, age, residence, occupation or profession of the applicant; must contain a brief record of his military career and history from the time of entering the service until the surrender; said application must be endorsed by two member of the Association in good standing, or accompanied by vouchers satisfactory to the Committees on Credentials, and must be accompanied by the initiation fees (without which it cannot be entertained), and shall be read in open session and referred to the Committee on Credentials, to be reported and acted on at the next regular meeting, unless further time be granted.
